





WHEN REPAINTING DEPTH MARKINGS AND "NO DIVING" SIGNS

FOLLOW THESE REQUIREMENTS

- Four inch letters or larger (or equivalent pictorial sign for "No Diving")
- Within two feet of the water's edge (or 6 inches back of the gutter)
- Slip resistant surface
- At maximum depth, minimum depth, break between deep and shallow end, and intermediate points.
- Not more than 25 feet apart
- Contrasting color with the background
- In nearest six inch or half foot increments
- "Ft" or "In" may be used. Hash marks may not be used.
- At least 2 marker at wading pools, spas, and zero entry
- Zero Depth entrance marked as "Zero Depth", "0 Feet", or "0 Inches"
- "No Diving" signs are not required at wading pools or spas
